

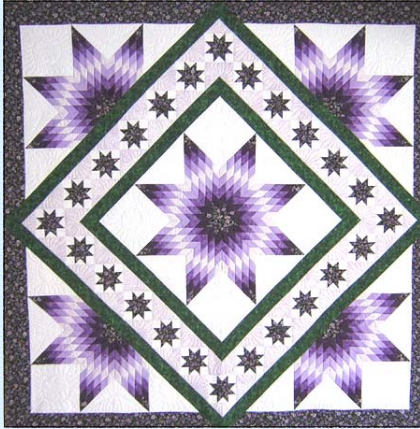

For 2009, Retreaters will choose from these five patterns.



"Celestial Gardens," a gorgeous quilt, is an intermediate to advanced pattern that features a centered "lone-star" surrounded by smaller Lemoyne stars. It's radiating colors make a stunning 94 x 94" quilt!



"Midnight Garden" is one of Roxanne's finest and was featured in a recent issue of "The Quilter Magazine." It is available in two size, lap 55x72" and queen, 92x108". It's on-point block centers are perfect for a fabulous focus fabric. This pattern is suitable for confident beginners who have made a few quilts. Those with intermediate & advanced skills will also enjoy stitching up Midnight Garden.



"Falling Stars" is available in two sizes, 64x74" lap/twin, and 88x102" queen. All quilters that have mastered basic skills will delight in making this quilt. Falling Stars is a great pattern for a special focus fabric, (how about a beautiful Asian or floral?) and its friendship star blocks are a true delight.



We fell totally in love with the intermediate to advanced pattern, "Quilters Rose" and thus decided to offer five patterns for '09. This pattern is available ONLY in a 60 x 77" large lap size because the pattern would be very difficult to enlarge (of course you can add borders on your own.) It features artfully arranged "rose" blocks inter-mingled with sculptured borders accented with bias trim. **MAGNIFICENT!**



This yummy quilt is a true beauty. Called "Crystal Garden," it features paper pieced floral blocks arranged around a centered floral medallion. Crystal Garden is available in two sizes, a wall/lap that measures 60x 60" and a queen measuring 88x88." Those with intermediate to advanced skills will enjoy making Crystal Garden.
